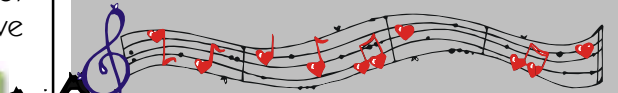
## Chapel Specials
